Dear IADS Family,

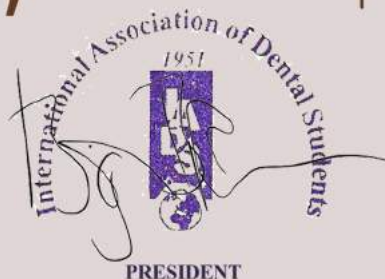

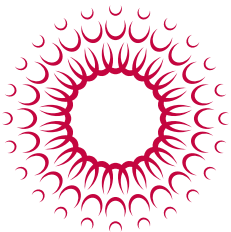
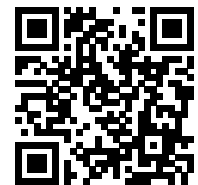
