• Marvin A. Fier, DDS, is presenting "Predictable, Profitable Restorative and Aesthetic Procedures," from 2 to 5 p.m. Fier will explain how newer materials and techniques can help you achieve less stress, happier patients and higher profits. A discussion of the new universal shade composites will be included. Total etch, selective etch and self-etch will be covered. This half-day seminar is also part of the Pediatric Program.

• Also today, "Botox and Facial Fillers for the Dental Practitioner: A Clinical Workshop and Demonstration" will be offered by Zev Schulhof, DMD, MD, from 9 a.m. to noon and 2 to 5 p.m. During this all-day seminar and workshop, there will be a brief discussion on the history, indications and types of facial fillers, as well as their combined use with Botulinum Toxin in the treatment of the aging face.


"Live" demonstrations follow in the afternoon, and mannequins will be available for participants to practice the hands-on portion of the program.


