Expo, Annual Global Orthodontic Conference, 3D Printing Conference, Oral Health Symposium, Pediatric Summit, Women's Program, Public Health Program, Special Needs Courses and Dental Laboratory Education.

One of today's educational highlights is Dr. Robert W. Frare's "Dental Anxiety, Fear, And Phobia," part of the Special Needs Forum.

While estimates vary, dental literature typically reports that 40 percent of the global population experiences anxiety or fear related to dentistry, while dental phobia affects 10 to 30 percent of the population.

This program will describe management strategies for anxiety, fear and phobia, which can apply to all dental patients.

Another highlight is the Global Population Health Summit, taking place in two sections today, one from 9:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., and the other from 2 to 5 p.m.

Under the theme "Ethics and Population Health," the summit will feature discussions of important potential factors that can impact population health and growth, such as ethics and human health research, sexual reproduction and population health, genetic engineering and gender reassignment, and euthanasia.

If you're looking for a workshop, consider Dr. Jonathan P. Kang's "Next Generation CBCT For Full Mouth Reconstruction." This course will discuss recent technological advancements that are now available and how these can help augment a thriving implant practice.

During this workshop, attendees

will learn about innovations in next-generation CBCT, 3-D facial scanners, digital oral design software and impression CT scans.

The courses continue on Tuesday, where you should be sure to check out Laura Nelson's course, "Hiring For Keeps: Finding People That Fit."
