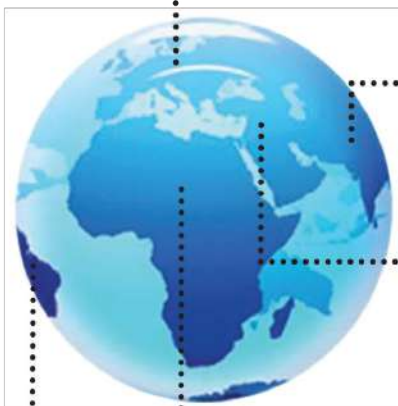

Luggage in their hands, enthusiasm in their heads, ambition in their hearts and sparkle in their eyes; they tied their countries' flags firm to their wrists yet they were in full willingness to expose their souls and minds and seize the first moment till the last one of TNT Beirut. That is how we bonded with our nine international trainees as they laid their feet in Beirut international airport on the 22nd of June flying all the way from UAE, Jordan, Iran, Iraq, Sudan and Egypt.

They began as trainees, stepped out as devoted trainers, vowed to pass their legacy to other IADS members.
