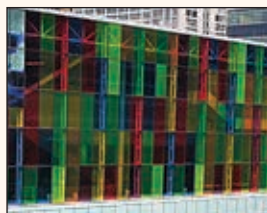

Education anchors CDA exhibit hall

At 'The Spot,' in two locations at the 2019 CDA Presents, you can attend up to 35 free lectures

The Spot Educational Theaters at CDA Presents The Art and Science of Dentistry, in Anaheim, Calif., will offer free one-hour lectures by industry experts during exhibit-hall hours on all three days of the convention. With two locations of The Spot, attendees have the opportunity to attend up to 35 free lectures covering topics such as ethics, informed consent, student loan refinancing and chronic wound therapy. Many lectures offer one unit of continuing education credit.

The first educational theater is located in Hall C of the Anaheim Convention Center exhibit hall, just steps from the main entrance and adjacent to the registration area. There attendees can catch lectures every hour on the hour from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Thursday and Friday, May 16–17, and from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday, May 18.

The Spot in Hall C doubles as the C.E. Pavilion, where attendees can verify the C.E. units of CDA Presents Anaheim courses they've completed, take course surveys

and email their course scans to themselves for future reference. Attendees can also stop there to learn about recently launched products within the dental industry and where to find the products and product experts on the exhibit hall floor.

The second educational theater is located in aisle 2000 in the back of Hall D, between the restaurant and concessions. Lectures at this location run on the same schedule as those in The Spot in Hall C — every hour on the hour during exhibit-hall hours. Work areas and a lounge are next to the second educational theater, but both locations offer seating and a place to recharge electronics.

Montréal hosts JDIQ, May 25–28

The 49th International Dental Days of Quebec (JDIQ), the annual conference of the Ordre des Dentistes du Québec, will be from May 25–28 (Saturday through Tuesday) at the Montréal Convention Center (the Palais des Congrès de Montréal) in Montréal, Quebec, near the heart of the old-world charm of historic Old Montréal.

The C.E. and exhibition event is the annual meeting place for Quebec dentists and dental-team members, while also attracting attendees from across the world. With more than 12,000 participants, it is considered the largest dental conference in Canada.

The mission of the Ordre des Dentistes du Québec, representing approximately 5,300 dentists, is to ensure the quality of dental services through high standards of practice and ethics and to promote oral health among the people of Quebec.

The C.E. courses feature theoretical and practical training presented by renowned

speakers from Canada and around the world. The courses and workshops focus on topics related to dental practice, as well as the technical and scientific advancements that influence the current and future practice of dentistry.

The meeting's two-day exhibit hall will be on Monday and Tuesday, May 27–28.

JDIQ 2019 marks the third edition of the CÉLABration event. In collaboration with the Order of Dental Technicians of Quebec (OTTDQ), the meeting provides a full

day of sessions and clinical tables, as well as an exhibition featuring specialized products and services.

the CDA Peer Review and Judicial Council and "Informed Consent: More Than a Signature," presented by The Dentists Insurance Company. 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Pediatric dentists heading to Chicago

Annual session of American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry returns this year to academy's hometown, from May 23–26

The annual session of the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry this year is in the academy's hometown, Chicago, from May 23–26.

The meeting's host site is the landmark Chicago Hilton on South Michigan Avenue, just across the street from Grant Park's 8th Street Fountain and Formal Gardens and a short stroll from the iconic Buckingham Fountain. Twelve blocks

north is the city's internationally known shopping destination, the Magnificent Mile.

Welcome reception at Museum of Science and Industry

The Sunstar Welcome Reception will be held at the Museum of Science and Industry, in Chicago's historic Hyde Park neighborhood. Attendees will be able to meet

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Among the museum's most famed highlights are opportunities to explore a full-size replica coal mine, wend through a German U-505 submarine captured during World War II, walk through a 40-foot water-vapor tornado, pilot a fighter-jet flight simulator, lord over a 3,500-square-foot model railroad and peer into the Apollo 8 command module.

Keynote from the first female pilot with the U.S. Air Force Thunderbirds

The opening ceremony keynote speaker is retired Colonel Nicole Malachowski, the first female pilot of the Air Force Thunderbird Aerial Demonstration Team. Her address, "Headwinds of Change," could also serve as an overarching theme of the meeting's scientific program, with an agenda packed full of timely topics, including pediatric esthetics, brain development, precision medicine, sleep apnea, sedation, dental benefits and an evidence-based training workshop.

The scientific sessions open on Thursday with the preconference course "Speak Up for Patient Health: Critical Conversations on Controversial Issues." The interactive session offers practical advice on how to effectively discuss difficult topics such as weight issues, eating disorders, substance use, transgender issues, pregnancy, sexual practices and sexually transmitted infections.

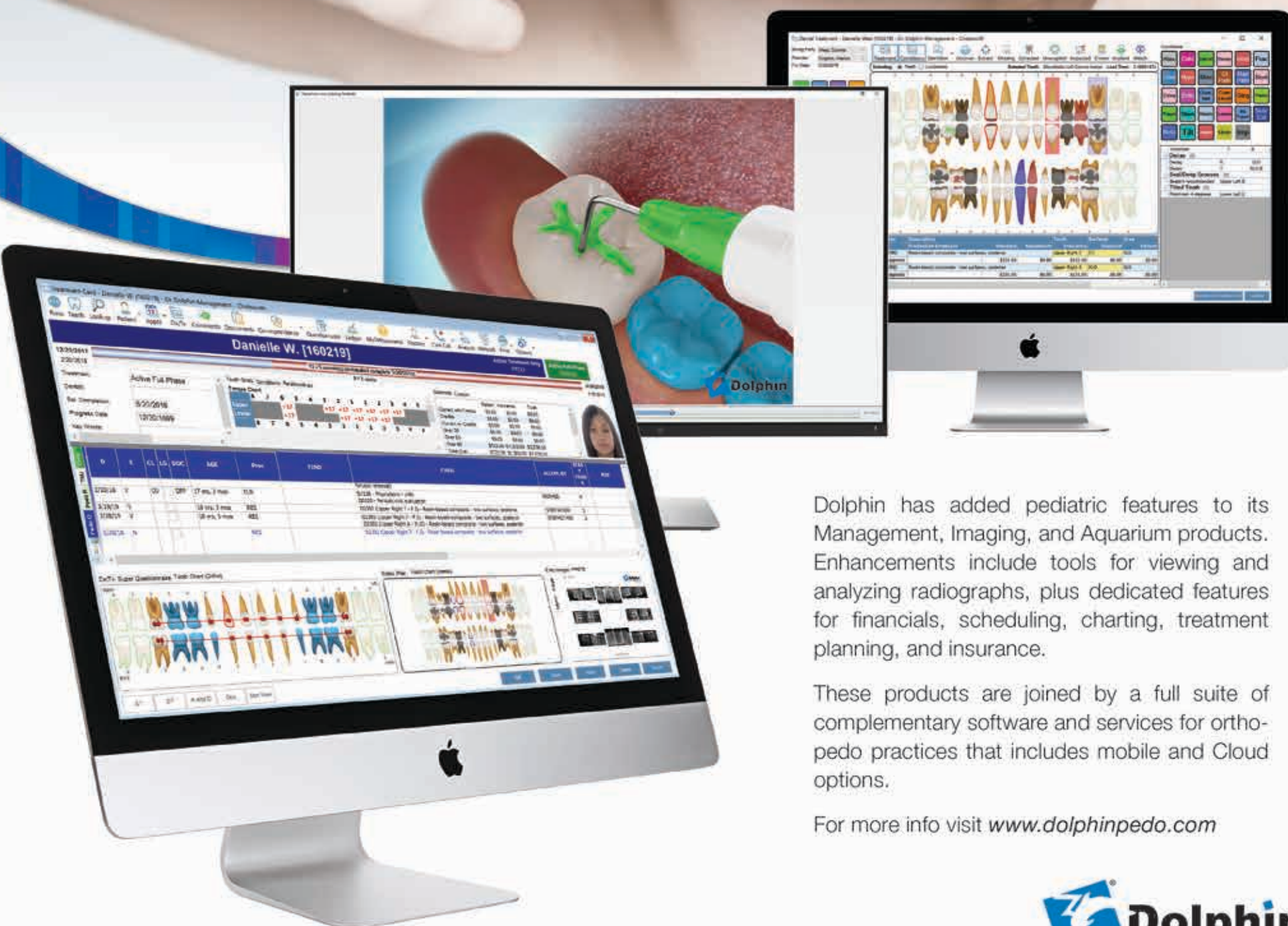

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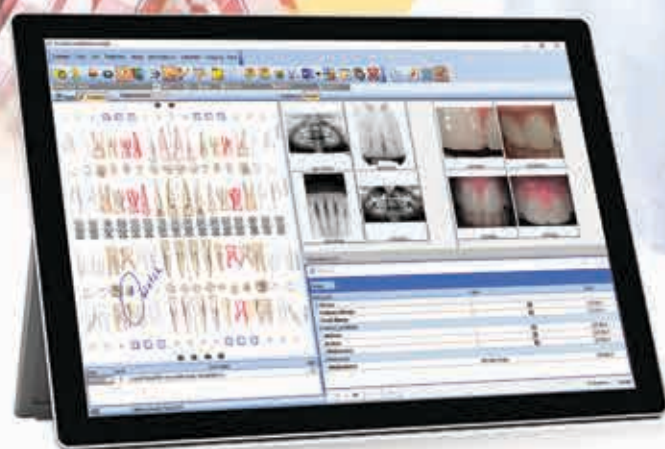
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
