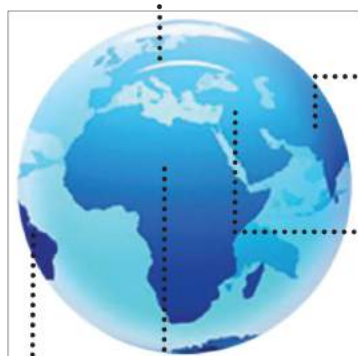

Northern Cyprus, or what I like to call, a little piece of heaven that fell by mistake to make the most gorgeous spot on planet.

Northern Cyprus is a part of the Turkish republic that is located at the north of Cyprus island, landing near both Lebanon and Turkey boundaries. As a part of the IADS program, training was held to increase the intellectual student capabilities.
