

### Treat pulpotomies with TheraCal PT

What's more, TheraCal PT does not require mixing like MTA, Steyer said. And further, unlike calcium hydroxide, it is moisture tolerant, she said. Another plus, Steyer said, is that it is radiopaque, allowing for easy identification and differentiation from recurrent decay and other restorative materials.

"What's great about this product is an easy application with its direct syringe," Steyer said. "We have a working time of minimum 45 seconds and a setting time



of maximum five minutes, so the child in the chair is not waiting and wiggling around. It's fast and easy."

"It is dual cured, so you'll be able to hit it with a light for 10 seconds, and then go ahead and immediately do the restoration without having the patient come back," she said.

"It has a great feature of calcium release and an alkaline pH, and it is a biocompatible product, which is important because previous pulpotomy treatment type materials weren't always biocompatible," Steyer said.
