pany's ECO II Amalgam Separators help reduce mercury contamination in the environment.

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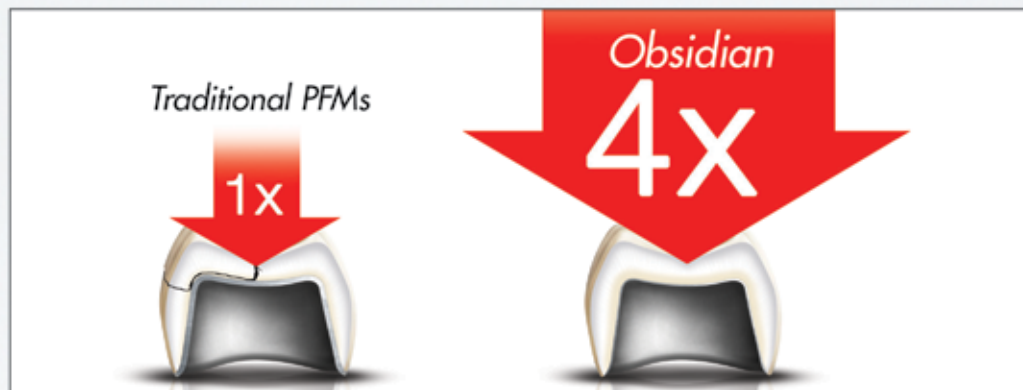


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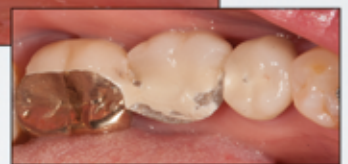

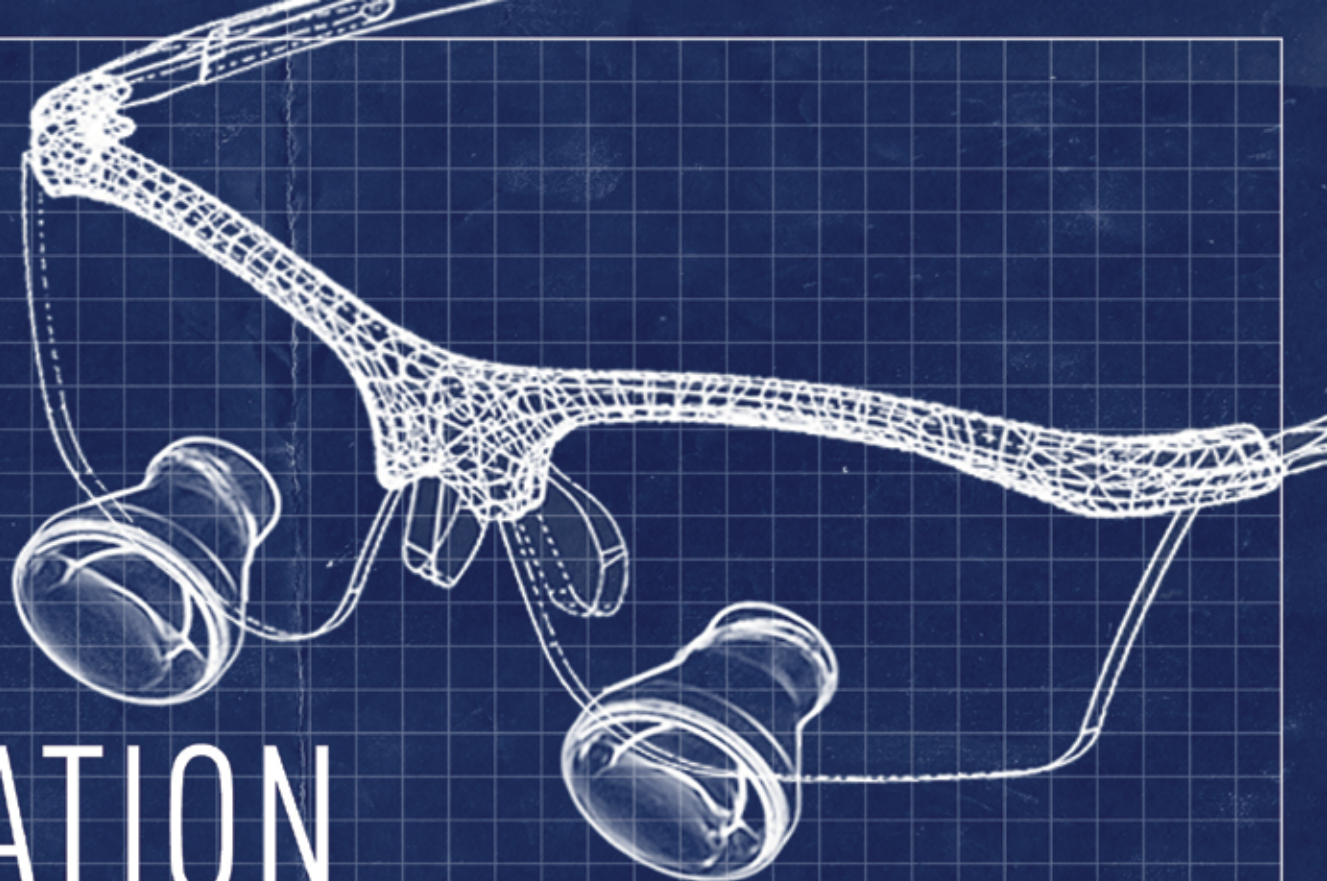
